# PREPARING TODAY FOR TOMORROWS DISASTERS - A CALL TO ACTION

## TRAINING OVERVIEW

**Friday, 6pm - 10pm**- the first evening of training will consist of all classroom work:

- Emergency preparedness and what that means (individual and family)
- Identify the hazards that threaten our community
- Disaster Psychology
- Terrorism

**Saturday, 8am - 6pm**– some classroom work with more of hands-on/practical application:

- Team Organization and ICS – how the CERT team will be activated during emergencies
- Disaster Medical Operations I and II – triage and first aid component
- Light Search and Rescue Operations

**Sunday, 8am – 6pm** – final day of training followed by an exercise to practice what has been taught:

- Fire suppression – fire extinguisher (when and how to use and which type of extinguisher for what type of fire)
- Course Review and Disaster Simulation Drill

**DRESS:** Closed-toe shoes (no sandals or open-toe shoes), comfortable shirt and Long pants (no shorts). There are activities that required bending/lifting.

*NBCERT encourages participation and trains people of a wide-range of ages and abilities. Teens (13-15) must be accompanied by an adult. Please contact the office with questions. Some content may be considered mature by some. Please sign up only if you plan to attend space is limited and often there is a waiting list.*

Missed portions of training can be made-up at later training offerings. Participants who do not complete the full 20 hours of training will get a certificate of units completed only and will remain trainee status of the NBCERT Team until course completed.
